

# Woodlands for Wildlife

## **An Introduction to Wildlife Gardening in Woodland areas**

This course is for anyone interested in learning some of the basics of wildlife gardening.  
No previous experience or knowledge is necessary.

The course involves carrying out simple practical tasks, which may include bending and lifting.

Please also make sure your Tetanus protection is up to date.

### **Course format:**

The course will be delivered in bite sized sessions of 2 hours at a time, usually on the site.

Learning is mainly through doing, with a skilled trainer to show you how.

You will be asked questions verbally or be observed while you work or asked to complete a questionnaire as part of the assessment for the certificate.

You will have the chance to be involved in the planning of the actual work on the site.

Courses are free and you will receive a certificate if you pass the assessment.

You will be asked to fill in an enrolment form at the start and a feedback form at the end of the course to help us learn from your experiences.

### **Practical Information about the course**

Please wear clothing and footwear suitable for outdoor activities and weather.

There are no toilets on site, and if you require refreshments you will need to bring along a flask or similar.
