

Woodlands for Wildlife

Plan of Work for 'Woodlands for Wildlife Course' - Catton Park

The course itself is run by BTCV on behalf of Norwich 21's 'Woodlands for Wildlife' program. The course will primarily take place in Fiddlewood and Night Plantation, with several sessions held, as agreed, at Catton Park.

The exact areas involved are highlighted on the attached map.

The course will be held on Friday mornings from 10am to 12 pm, for nine weeks starting from 1st October to the 26th November 2004, with two weeks off for half term (22nd & 29th October). Five of these sessions are planned to be held in Catton Park. If for any reason the schedule below has to be altered, BTCV will to inform you personally before any work is undertaken.

The schedule of work in Catton Park is planned as follows:

1st October:

Introduction to coppicing – sycamore in area 2 (SE corner to the left of the lodge).

8th October:

Coppice sycamore in areas 1 and 2 (The Dell and SE corner to the left of lodge).

15th October:

Remove bramble around Yew/holly trees in areas 1 and 2, some coppicing and small tree felling (sycamore) in areas 1 and 2.

19th November:

Fell/coppice sycamore windrow in area 4 (Southern end along Mile Cross Lane).

26th November:

Fell/coppice sycamore windrow in area 3 and 5.
