

CATTON PARK EARLY MORNING BIRD WALK

6th MAY 2007

Birds seen :-

Grey Heron	one flew over to south west
Lesser Black-backed Gull	one flew over
Wood Pigeon	large flock feeding on open grass (?100)
Collared Dove	single in woodland near Fiddlewood
Stock Dove	3 or four in isolated trees near the 'big oak'
Swift	about six over the Hall School
Green Woodpecker	One calling from Maids Head area
Great Spotted Woodpecker	Nest located in eastern wood (young heard calling)
Blackbird	common throughout
Song Thrush	one or two around the east and south margins
Robin	common throughout
Dunnock	single on Catton Hall boundary hedge
Wren	common throughout
Starling	one or two
Chiffchaff	3 or four singing males
Blackcap	About 6 singing males
Blue Tit	several
Great Tit	several
Jay	A pair in west woodland
Carrion Crow	one or two around - probable nest in west woodland
Magpie	In hedge at north-east corner (probable nest nearby)
Nuthatch	a nest located in the grounds of the Hall School
Goldcrest	a pair in bushes by the Lodge
Chaffinch	a few
